Any attorney wishing to serve as a substitute judge of the Twentieth Judicial District commencing upon appointment and compliance with the requirements of §16.1-69.9:1 *et seq.*, is asked to submit a letter of interest to Chief Judge Burke F. McCahill of the Twentieth Judicial Circuit, on or before close of business on Friday, February 17, 2006.

Substitute district court judges are appointed by the Chief Circuit Court Judge. The requirements for substitute judges are found in Chapter 4.1 of Title 16.1 of the Code of Virginia. Please note that a substitute judge must reside within the 20th Judicial District, *i.e.*, Loudoun, Fauquier and Rappahannock Counties; that under § 16.1-69.9:1(d) a criminal history background check is now required; and that terms are for six years.
